- You agree to providing feedback on the event by either providing a 30 second – 1-minute video OR a written statement of approximately 300 words during or after the conference. This may need to be presented or shared back to students at your tertiary institute.
- You agree to being a part of promotional material (video/images) regarding your time at Tū Kaha 2018 that may be posted up on website, Facebook, Instagram or via emails.
- You must be able to provide your own transport and accommodation to the event held in Palmerston North (Ngā Pou Mana will provide a small contribution/koha when you arrive at the conference of petrol and/or grocery vouchers to help support you up to the value of \$100).
- You must provide proof or evidence that you are in an Allied Health study pathway (send us a letter/email/student ID from your tertiary institute).
- You must have Māori descent, please provide your Iwi details below.
